In the states of Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh, UCO Bank branches numbering 239 have come to a standstill due to today's Strike. We place on record our deep sense of appreciation to all our rank and file who have befittingly manifested their anguish and resentment over the anti workforce approach and attitude of the Top Management responding to the call of STRIKE, mindless of sacrifices involved.
